### EXECUTIVE ORDER

In view of the problems faced by general public especially in times of emergency and the affects it had to the business community, the Government decided to lift the ongoing Pedestrian Day with immediate effect.

The Government, however, applauds the initiative taken by the former Government and appreciates the objectives and rationale behind introducing the Pedestrian Day. Therefore, Pedestrian Day shall continue to be observed on June 5 every year coinciding with the World Environment Day.

Relevant Ministries and Agencies are hereby instructed to come up with advocacy programmes to promote and create awareness on living healthy lifestyles and preserving the environment. Further, the Government also invites suggestions and proposals from the public, if any, to promote healthy living and environment awareness. Proposals may be sent to the Cabinet Secretariat for consideration by the Cabinet.

This Executive Order rescinds earlier Government Circular C-3/146/338 of 22 November 2012 issued by the Government.
