

EXECUTIVE ORDER

As per the National Environment Protection Act 2007, the National Environment Commission shall recommend ratification of bilateral and multilateral environmental instruments to the Parliament for subsequent enactment. Further, the NEC shall be the body to issue directives to relevant agencies or bodies for the purpose of recommending to the Parliament to declare any species and plant and/or animals as endangered including their habitat. Similarly this procurement shall also be followed for declaring any part of the country to be a national park, wildlife reserve, protected forest, biosphere reserve, critical watershed and other such categories meriting protection.

The 35th meeting of the National Environment Commission has recognized the need to ensure strict compliance of this requirement by all concerned agencies with immediate effect.
